<b>Engineering notes:</b> 1 Engineering services are billed at the stated hourly rate in ¼ hour increments. Preliminary reviews and variance reviews are subject to a two hour minimum charge. 2 Customer priority service is a customer initiated escalation of a design review package, that advances the package to the front of the existing elevating and amusement devices work queue. Advancement in the work queue carries a 2x charge relative to the hourly engineering labour rate. Priority service aims to return a registration within the specified number of working days, however if additional information is required the priority service request will result in a TSSA engineering request for information letter. Customer priority service is accommodated only if processing queues allow. Associated fees are non-refundable if registration is not completed due to an incomplete package.

Does not apply to periodic inflatable inspections. 2 Minimum charge includes all travel time and ½ hour inspection time per inspection per device. Additional time will be billed at the hourly inspection labour rate. 3 A flat charge of \$130 will apply to all periodic and initial inflatable inspections, which is inclusive of all regular inspection and travel time. A minimum charge of \$300 per site will be applied in lieu of the flat charge in cases where there are two or fewer periodic inflatable inspections on a site visit. Follow-up and subsequent inspections to periodic inflatable inspections are billable at the standard follow-up and subsequent hourly rates listed above. 4 Minimum charge is per device and includes all travel time and 1 hour of inspection time per follow-up or subsequent inspection. The hourly inspection rate applies after one inspection hour per device.

<b>Licensing, Registration, Certification and Other Fee notes:</b> 1 Licensing, registration, certification and examination fees are non-refundable. Registration fees are billed annually. Examination fees are payable for all examinations and re-writes taken by the candidate, regardless of whether the outcome is a pass or a failure. An exam re-write counts as a separate examination and will be billed accordingly. 2 Invigilation fees will be billed on a per invigilator per exam basis. As a result, multiple invigilation fees may be applied for one sitting if two or more examinations are administered simultaneously or two or more invigilators are required to properly administer the examination (i.e. a large number of students and/or multiple rooms are involved). Should a customer request on-site invigilation, the TSSA will determine how many invigilators are required based on the specifics of the customer request. On-site invigilation fees are charged specifically for the service of on-site invigilation, and do not replace or subsidize the regular examination fees that are charged on a per-student basis.
