## Pre-Examination of a Go Kart

Under Ontario's **Technical Standards and Safety Act**

Amusement Devices Regulation (O.Reg. 221/01)

### Duty of licence holder

A licence holder shall ensure with respect to each amusement device operated by the licence holder that the device is operated in accordance with this Regulation, the technical dossier filed with the director and the manufacturer's instructions, where applicable, relating to the device;

**licence holder** shall ensure that the maintenance of each amusement device operated by the licence holder includes,

- a) the carrying out of all safety-related recommendations issued by the manufacturer with respect to the amusement device;
- b) the checking and examination of all parts and functions at intervals sufficient to ensure the safe operation of the amusement device;
- c) the cleaning, lubricating and adjusting of all parts at intervals sufficient to ensure the safe operation of the amusement device; and
- d) the repairing or replacing of worn, defective, damaged or broken parts on the amusement device. O. Reg. 221/01, s. 11 (3).

**Licence holder** shall carry out or have carried out by a mechanic a pre- examination of the device to ensure that it complies with the technical dossier and conforms to this Regulation

### Deficiencies Listed (If Applicable)

To verify conformance, the examiner must refer to his/her copy of the filed Technical Dossier, including drawings, the standard covering the Amusement device, applicable bulletins and his/her knowledge as a "mechanic" of Ontario's **Technical Standards and Safety Act**, Amusement Devices Regulation and relevant standards.

**Inspection:** An inspection shall be arranged no later than Thursday preceding the week in which the inspection is requested. At that time, verbal assurance of the conformance and completion are required. (Exception - see Deficiencies.) When the inspector arrives he/ she will require this Pre-Examination form, duly completed.

**Deficiencies:** An inspector may proceed with inspection with deficiencies listed above at his/her discretion.
