

NEW PROCESS: BPV CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION



WHAT HAS CHANGED?

Currently, obtaining a BPV Certificate of Inspection (COI) is done through your insurer. As of July 1, 2018, all owners/operators of a boiler or pressure vessel must get their COI from the Technical Standards and Safety Authority (TSSA) before the current COI expiry date for their device(s).

The below steps outline how to obtain your next COI:

1 INSPECTION

Once your BPV device has passed its inspection, you will need to contact TSSA to receive your Certificate of Inspection through the TSSA COI Online Portal.

2 LOG IN

To obtain your Certificate of Inspection, please visit **www.tssa.org/COIportal**.

You will log in using the email and password provided to you by TSSA and will be guided through the process to obtain your Certificate of Inspection.

NOTE: Access to the online portal opens July 1, 2018.

3 PAY A FEE

As a part of the process, you will need to pay a fee associated with the COI. Fees are dependent on the frequency of inspection and can be paid online or invoiced. If invoiced, payment must be received prior to the expiry of the current COI. Fees are outlined on the COI portal.
