



Inspection Orders on Elevators

Data Description

Inspection Orders Issued on Current Installed Elevating Devices	
Summary: A listing of all inspection orders issued by device.	
Data	Data Definition
Elevating Devices Number (Device)	This is a unique system generated number assigned to each elevating device at the time of the initial installation request. This device itself is identified by this number in a variety of ways. This number is unique and not sequential and serves as an index field to other data sets.
TSSA Standard Order Number	TSSA Inspection Order Number. This number is unique and represents a specific inspection order, if one exists at the time of the inspection and was selected.
Regulation Reference	Code/Act or Regulation Identification associated to the TSSA Standard Order Number.
Clause Number	Number from specific Code/Act or Regulation referencing the requirement/non-compliance associated to the TSSA Standard Order Number.
Clause Text	Clause Text from specific clause number found within the specific Code/Act or Regulation referencing the requirement/non-compliance
Directive	Wording indicating the compliance requirements
Inspections Additional Information	Free text written by the inspector to provide more clarity to the customer.
RISK SCORE	Derived through Risk Analysis
Inspection Type	The type of inspection completed. i.e. Periodic Inspection, Unscheduled Inspection, Initial Inspection, Follow-Up Inspection. Definitions can be provided if required.
Date of Issue	Date of the inspection order.
Status of Inspection Order	Inspection orders have a lifecycle. The status indicates where the order is in the lifecycle.
Inspection Number	System generated unique number for the inspection. This is the inspection report number printed on the inspection reports.
Days to Comply	The number of days to comply with the inspection order.
Compliance Date	Date on which compliance is required.
Customer Ordered to Comply	The name of the individual or entity/organization ordered to comply.
