Proof of Work Experience - Mandatory Information Requirement

Applicants are required to submit, along with the application, a letter from your past or present employer, written on company letterhead and signed by an officer of the company. The letter must demonstrate most recent employment as a mechanic in the fuels safety industry.

Examination

Applicants must have successfully passed the local knowledge examination with a minimum of 75% in order to obtain an Ontario certificate. Questions for this open book examination will be based on Ontario's acts, regulations, and code adoption documents pertaining to fuels safety.
