

## In accordance with O. Reg 211/01 the following External Emergency Response Procedures are in place at the P38 Energy Barry's Bay propane bulk plant regarding response outside the property and to ensure safety for the surrounding public.

## This guideline is applicable only to the P38 Energy Barry's Bay Propane Facility.

In case of fire/incident, personnel have been instructed to act with caution, follow the emergency procedures and evacuate. As soon as the P38 Energy staff have evacuated the area they are to contact emergency services (911) and provide them with the address, nearest intersection, and the nature of the incident. The township has an existing emergency plan in place, the Corporation of the Township of Madawaska Valley Emergency Response Plan, which will be undertaken in the event of an emergency. A Municipal Emergency Control Group (MECG) will coordinate provision of essential services necessary to minimize the effect to the community, including mobilizing emergency services and equipment, ensuring support to the emergency site, coordinating the evacuation of nearby inhabitants/public receptors, and notifying/liaising with government and public agencies as necessary. P38 Energy personnel shall offer advice and assistance to the emergency responders if requested.

When an emergency is taking place at the P38 Energy Barry's Bay facility, the branch manager (or alternate) at the site will be responsible for:

- Ensuring all personnel are accounted for;
- Orientating emergency responders who arrive on site;
- Assisting emergency responders as required; and
- Contacting management and updating them of the emergency.

Management will determine if activation of the ERAC is required. The ERAP number is ERP-0010-103. An emergency number 1-800-265-0212 is available 24/7 to activate the plan. This number is posted at the facility. ERAC is available 24/7 and initial consultation and advice is provided by Response Managers (RMs). Remedial Measures Advisors (RMAs) and Response Teams with necessary equipment are dispatched as required.

The surrounding public within the hazard distance has previously been issued notification letters from P38 Energy that informs them that in the event of an emergency they are to adhere to instructions from the local emergency responders for their recommended action and potential evacuation.
