Inspection: An inspection shall be arranged no later than Thursday preceding the week in which the inspection is requested. At that time, verbal assurance of the conformance and completion are required. (Exception - see Deficiencies.) When the inspector arrives he/ she will require this Pre-Examination form, duly completed.		Deficiencies: An inspector may proceed with inspection with deficiencies listed above at his/her discretion.
