**Subject:** Certificate Holder Requirements to Refuel and Work on Propane Vehicles

This is to clarify the requirements for the certification of persons working on or refuelling propane vehicles.

Section 6 and 8 of Ontario Regulation 211/01 requires a person to be a holder of a certificate or ROT for that purpose if they handle, install, purge, activate, repair, service or remove any appliance or equipment or other thing employed or to be employed in the handling or use of propane.

From Ontario Regulation 211/01:

Certificate required to handle propane

6. (1) No person shall handle propane unless the person is the holder of a certificate or ROT for that purpose.

Certificate required for various activities

8. (1) No person shall install, alter, purge, activate, repair, service or remove any appliance or equipment or other thing employed or to be employed in the handling or use of propane unless the person is the holder of a certificate or ROT for that purpose.

The following table outlines the minimum certificates that the persons working on or refuelling the propane vehicle are required to possess within the scope of their certificate.

Type of Equipment and Type of Work	Acceptable Certificate
1. Refuelling Propane Vehicles	PPO 1, 2, 3 or ROT
2. Installing, Repair, Maintenance, Servicing and Inspection of Aftermarket Propane Converted Vehicles	ICE-P
3. Repair, Maintenance, Servicing and Inspection of OEM Propane Vehicles	ICE-P
4. Repair, Maintenance, Servicing and Inspection of Recreational Vehicles where the Propane is used for Appliances, including Tanks	G.1, G.2, RV.1 or RV.2 under direct supervision of an RV.1
