



Act Early to Reduce Compliance Cost

Boilers & Pressure Vessels for Agricultural Operations

Stay Safe. Stay Compliant. Report your Pressure Equipment Today.

Ontario Regulation 220/01 requires owners of boilers and pressure vessels (BPVs) used for agricultural operations to register their pressure equipment with TSSA and have it inspected to ensure its safe installation, operation, proper maintenance, and compliance with regulatory requirements.

One Inspection: Book by January 31, 2027

To support agricultural owners and operators with meeting regulatory requirements, TSSA has introduced an initial "One Inspection" approach since July 2021. Owners and operators who schedule a site assessment before **January 31, 2027**, can take advantage of this cost-effective approach where:

- All BPVs are inspected and charged under one site assessment visit
- Significant cost savings since all BPV devices are charged together under one visit

First Inspection: Book from February 1, 2027

Site assessments booked from **February 1, 2027**, will fall under TSSA's standard inspection model known as a "**First Inspection**" where:

- Each BPV will be inspected and billed **per device**
- Higher total cost

**As a not-for-profit organization, the fee is based on cost recovery.*

Act Now in 3 Simple Steps

Step 1: Scan the QR Code or visit [TSSA Portals](#) to create a TSSA Client Portal Account



Step 2: Request an Inspection

- Select "**Other**" as the inspection type
- In the Notes field, write "**Agriculture**"

Step 3: Submit Inspection Request

TSSA will contact you with 30 days' notice to schedule a site assessment.
